#### **MEMBER NEWS**

Veda Zuponcic organized the Shostakovich 100 Festival at Rowan University in March. A lecture By Maya Pritsker; a performance by Miss Zuponcic's students of the 24 Preludes and Fugues of DD Shostakovich; and a two day performathon of music of Shostakovich and Mozart, which also raised money for the NJMTA, were held. More than 100 students and 12 teachers participated in the two week-end event. Additionally, Miss Zuponcic performed the Shostakovich First Piano Concerto with the Festival Orchestra, conducted by Gavriel Heine. Miss Zuponcic travels to Serbia and Montenegro in late March to

adjudicate the Nis International Competition. She will also perform a solo recital as part of the Competition schedule. She continues to direct the **Northern Lights Music Festival** in Aurora, Minnesota.
